- † **Edward George Bath**, Acting Bombardier, Royal Field Artillery died 13 Nov 1916 age 26 Battle of the Somme.
- † **Edward James Care**, Private, 8th (Service) Battalion, Prince Albert's (Somerset Light Infantry) died 11 Apr 1917 age about 36 Arras Offensive 1917.
- † **Ernest William Carter**, Private, 8th Battalion, Prince Albert's (Somerset Light Infantry) died 28 Apr 1917 age 20 Arras Offensive 1917.
- † **Percy Harry Doel**, Private, 5th Battalion, Queen's Own (Royal West Kent Regiment) died 28 Mar 1918 age about 24 First Battle of Arras 1918.
- † **William Augustus Spencer Edwards**, Major, 7th Battalion, The Prince of Wales's (North Staffordshire Regiment) Mentioned in Despatches, died of wounds on 30 Apr 1916 age 41 Amara, Mesopotamia.
- † **George Eveleigh Longman**, Private, 8th Battalion, Prince Albert's (Somerset Light Infantry) reported missing assumed to have been killed in action, 28 Apr 1917 age about 32 Arras Offensive.
- † **Roy Douglas Male**, Private, 1st/4th Battalion, Wiltshire Regiment died 13 Nov 1917 age 25 El Mesmiyeh Palestine.
- † **Walter Lewin Male**, Private, 1st/4th Battalion, Hampshire Regiment died 31 Mar 1917 age about 21 Baghdad, Mesopotamia.
- † **William Alfred Ambrose Morris**, Lance Corporal, 1st Battalion, King's Royal Rifle Corps died 27 Jul 1916 age 37 Battle of the Somme.
- † **Frederick John Perrett**, Private, 1st/4th Battalion, Wiltshire Regiment died 24 Jun 1915 age about 29 Delhi, India.
- † **Charles Vaughan Rose**, Private, 1st (Royal) Dragoons died 24 Mar 1918 age 22 First Battle of the Somme 1918.
- † **Joseph Henry Rose**, Private, Welsh Guards, killed in action 21 Jun 1916 age 43 Brandhoek, Belgium.
- † **Ernest Albert Rouse**, Private, 1st Battalion, Prince Albert's (Somerset Light Infantry), died 1 Jul 1916 age about 34 Somme.
- † **Arthur Sharp**, Gunner, 125 Battery, Royal Field Artillery, died 4 Jun 1917 age 26 Pas-de-Calais, Nord, France.
- † **Charles Smith**, Private, 1st Canadian Infantry Brigade. (see note)
- † **William Henry Smith**, Private, 1st Battalion, 1st Canadian Infantry Brigade. Died 22 Aug 1915 age 24 Ypres, Belgium.
- † **William Taylor**, Gunner, Canadian Field Artillery, 1st Canadian Division Ammunition Column, died 24 Feb 1916 age 26, Bailleul, Nord, France.
- † **Robert Edward Turner**, Lance Corporal, 1st Battalion, Prince Albert's (Somerset Light Infantry), died 7 May 1918 age 37 Pas-de-Calais, Nord, France.

Note: Charles Smith emigrated from England sometime after 1891, but no further information has been found.
